Situated at Zebra Country Estate home to four renowned Country Lodges a mere 30km from the Zambezi turnoff on the R573 outside of Pretoria, the African Bushveld provides the perfect backdrop for training the leaders of the future. Legend Hospitality School occupies Leopards Lair Lodge and students reside at the lodge in the safe and secure environment. All bedrooms are equipped with beds, study area and en-suite bathrooms, shared between two students. All meals are provided and all training is conducted at the facilities of this lodge as well as the other four lodges on the property. The school is spending substantial amount of money on upgrading the existing lodge kitchen into a five star training kitchen, equipped with the latest equipment and training stations per student – definitely achieving a standard of excellence which will be difficult to match.

Hospitality Courses on offer:

Full Time Course (16 months)

• International Hospitality Management Diploma

The course consists of four main components. Even though the course is management orientated it covers all aspects of the hospitality industry, providing the students with equal opportunity to decide which facet of hospitality is best suited to his needs in planning his future.

All students will sign a binding contract with the School for the period of training.

The above fee includes the following:

- All **study material** required for City & Guilds Modules
- Full **year's ingredients** for all practical classes in food preparation & culinary arts;
- **Examination costs** to City & Guilds International, including ingredients of practical Exams.
- Compulsory **first aid course** with a certificate
- A **preliminary wine course** with a certificate
- **Uniform**
 - 2 x Embroided chef's jackets
 - 2 x Full Formal Uniform including Hotel school Jacket





The above fee includes the following: (Continued)

- Student **registration fee** with City & Guilds
- A one year membership fee to the **South African Chef's Association**;
- **Accommodation** for all students at lodge of training in newly constructed Leopard's Lair Lodge. (Students stay where they train.)
- **3 x student meals per day** – weekend's own meals to be provided.
- **HACCP and Serve Safe training** with Legend certificate
- Study reference material from School library as well as **internet access** for student projects
- **Knife set** compulsory and as prescribed by LHS

2. The above fee excludes the following:

- Additional books and stationery that is compulsory or prescribed for students personal use.
- **Transport** – students **MUST** have own mode of transport – essential on property
- **Pocket money** – essential living on a country lodge outside main metropolitan
- All or any other **sundry expense** not included in fee but which will require students attendance - day trips/ function work outside normal students working environment i.e. KKNK music festival
- **Personal Computer or Laptop** – Even though there are computer facilities available for students it is recommended, **but not compulsory**, for students to have their own. This allows them to start building their own database knowledge backup for the future.

Short Courses (to upgrade your skills or to attain an entry level qualification – entry level is grade 10 learners & older)

Two types of short courses on offer:

Skills Foundation – consisting of four sessions and a fifth session for an exam with a certificate qualification via City & Guilds.

Skills Proficiency – consisting of four sessions and a fifth session for an exam with a certificate qualification via City & Guilds.

- The above courses will mostly be spread over a five week period with one session a week predetermined by the School.
- Each session will be from 16:00 until 21:00 on the day. A minimum of 10 to a maximum of 16 participants are required for each program.
- We can present this at Zebra country lodge or at schools to avoid learners and parents having to drive out to Zebra country lodge.





- The course fee will be R2400.00 per course and includes the exam fees and all ingredients.
- Minimum qualification required for all short courses are grade 10.

Informal cooking classes

Informal cooking classes are for people who want to know more about food and cooking and are not interested in an official qualification. These once off demonstrations will be advertised in advance. Bookings are essential – enquiries are accepted for groups of minimum 10 pax – great get together for friend and couples!
